Main Point

The church should know how to identify faithful pastoral leadership.

Key Ideas

- 1. A faithful pastor is a leader to be remembered
 - God sets men in into pastoral leadership to make a difference in our lives, not just do ministry or lead the church.
- 2. A faithful pastor speaks the word of God
 - An elder with no bible is an elder with no authority.
- 3. A faithful pastor has a way of life worth imitatiing
 - Holiness is taught through words, but caught in example.
- 4. A faithful pastor focuses on Jesus Christ
 - Jese is the constant. The center of the pastor's life is not ministry, but Christ.
